

North Cougar Band Takes National Title

The CMS North band was selected as a National Wind Ensemble winner this past week by a select panel of university directors.

The North band was chosen as a National Winner in the Mark of Excellence, Wind Band Honors Project, a competition supported and promoted by The Foundation for Music Education. Held in Washington, DC, one hundred sixty-one bands representing forty-two states competed to make the top ten cut.

Adjudicators for this contest were John Whitwell, Director of Bands Emeritus - Michigan State University, Dr. Steven Peterson, Director of Bands - Ithaca College, and Dr. Frank Wickes, Director of Bands - Louisiana State University.

The North Band total scored 298.6 out of a possible 300 points.

The Cougar musicians have just come off the State Honor Band Title for the second time in 5 years and are in preparations for their trip to Austin and San Antonio to perform at the state capital and the State Texas Music Educators convention in February.

The 347-member strong the band is off to a great start on another rewarding year with exciting performances for all.
